WHY WE DO IT

- In 2025, more than 313,000 men in the U.S. will be diagnosed with prostate cancer.
- More than 35,700 are projected to die of the disease.
- Globally, 1.4 million men are diagnosed per year.
- The burden is not borne equally: 1 in 6 Black men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer in his lifetime (vs. 1 in 8 white men) and are more than twice as likely to die.
